

# Fire Warden Training

### About the course



This course is delivered and assessed by **Emergency Dynamics (APL Group Pty Ltd) (RTO no 3586)**.

This course provides students with the skills and knowledge required to undertake first response to fire incidents and to operate as key members of an emergency control organisational system.

### Learning outcomes

- The knowledge and skills to be achieved in this training encompass the following:
- Site-specific alarm systems and response
- Making decisions appropriate to the emergency situation
- Site-specific emergency procedures and response plans
- Characteristics of fire and fuel types
- Use of extinguishing agents and basic fire fighting equipment
- Communicating clearly with key personnel and responsible authorities
- Conducting an evacuation of a building

### Who should study this course?

All those who are assigned fire warden duties in the building and construction workplace.

### Master Builders entry requirements

Participants must be physically capable of operating a Fire Extinguisher.
