

Green Card – Spill kit Induction

About the course

This **non-accredited short course** is delivered by **Master Builders Association of Victoria (RTO no 3935)**.

Master Builders believes environmental training should achieve the same level of compliance as site safety training. The “Green Card” will offer basic awareness in a similar role to the White Card (Construction Induction Training). This program will help you to address the requirements of your environmental management system.

Learning outcomes

Students will have gained the skills and knowledge to:

- Enhance Environmental Awareness
- Understand the legal and policy obligations to respond to an environmental spill
- Utilise Environmental Preparedness - Spill Kits
- Appropriately use Spill Kits and absorbent products
- Utilise Erosion, Sedimentation and Dust Control Measures
- Become familiar with procedures for minimising erosion, sedimentation and dust.

Who should study this course?

This course is suitable for all on site personnel, including site managers, OHS&E coordinators and contractors.

Training recommendations

Learners enrolling for the Green Card – Spill Kit Induction course are recommended to have

- CPCCOHS1001A Work safely in construction industry or;
- CPCCWHS1001 Prepare to work safely in the construction industry prior to course commencement.
